Prepare your extended abstract in a PDF format. Microsoft Word and LaTeX user template files are available from the Web-page. The paper format should be A4, **two pages maximum**.

The title should be bold-faced and center-lined.

The list of authors should be in italic and center-lined.

The body of the abstract should be written in 10 pt font.

Illustrations must appear within the designated margins. Caption and number every illustration.

List and number all bibliographical references at the end of the paper. The references can be numbered in alphabetic order or in order of appearance in the document[1]. When referring to them in the text, type the corresponding reference number in square brackets as shown at the end of this sentence[2].
