Short Bio: Abdulhalim Dandoush is associate Professor at the engineering school ESME-Sudria in France and the head of the department "Computing, Modeling and Digital Technologies". He obtained a Master degree in Networking and a PhD in information technology from INRIA and the university of Nice-Sophia Antipolis in 2006 and in 2010 respectively. Before to join ESME, he worked as Expert Engineer at INRIA-Sophia Antipolis within the INRIA-Alstom Transport joint Lab. His research interests lie on the performance evaluation and optimization of network protocols and functions. He was leading the ONF/ONOS teaching brigade in 2017-2018. He worked at the University of Nice-Sophia Antipolis in France as assistant and associate to research and teaching for between 2006 and 2010 and as an assistant professor at the University of Tishreen in Syria and the Arab Academy for Sciences and Technology in Egypt between 2011 and 2014. He served as general co-chair, publicity, session chair and TPC member for several conferences. He is the co-founder of the cyber security track and also the AI track at ESME within the computing and digital technologies department.
